Education Assistants Appreciation Week

Last week was Education Assistant Appreciation Week. We have 45 amazing Education Assistants (EAs) at Vasse PS.

Our EAs include Mainstream and Special Educational Needs (SEN). The Mainstream EAs work in the Kindy, Pre-Primary, Year 1 and 2 areas and support teachers in the delivery of the education program and supervision of students. SEN EAs work in the area of special needs, supporting teachers in working with students and delivering specialised intervention programs such as Mini and MacLit, speech programs, Kitchen Garden, Chicken Club, and individual plans. EAs work directly with students or may oversee larger groups to allow the teacher to work with students either one-on-one or in small groups.

As you can imagine, they need a diverse range of skills and often need to use initiative and adapt to situations with little or no notice. They work hard at developing relationships with the students and teachers. There are often challenges, but there are also rewards, especially seeing a child's skills and capacity develop throughout their schooling journey.

I'm sure the whole community agrees with me when I say we are blessed with our EA team at Vasse PS.

Compass

Over the past few weeks you have received communication about the newly implemented school management system called Compass.

Compass is a part of the Department of Education's Kaartdijin initiative which aims to modernise elements of WA Public schools' information system and communication, amongst other capabilities. Cape Naturaliste College is also transitioning to Compass so this will streamline the communication for you as your children move to CNC.

Some of the things you will notice at this point in time with Compass are;

- Sign in and out at the reception using the iPad has a different look;
- If a behaviour issue is recorded for your child you will receive a notification email. This email will be sent once the behaviour has been entered into the system;



In time, you may notice other additions, however we will always endeavour to let you know prior.

2025 Classes and Enrolments

If you know that your children will not be attending Vasse PS in 2025 we asked that you inform the office as soon as possible.



This is important as we have begun planning our class structures. We will start working on student class placement decisions early next term. This is a lengthy and detailed process so any information regarding your plans in 2025 would be greatly appreciated.

Our **Kindy enrolments** for Kindy next year have been very strong and we will have four groups. It is looking as though we may have to establish a waitlist for places. However, if we have more enrolments we may be in a position to establish another Kindy class (a fifth group) in 2025.

If you know of families who are yet to enrol or considering enrolling, please encourage them to contact the school as soon as possible.

The 2025 class construction process will commence early next term. If there are considerations you feel we need to know when placing your child please email myself and the class teacher. This does not guarantee that we can accommodate the request or consideration, however it will alert us to the issue.

Parenting Session

Our Student Services Committee recently met with Samantha Kurowski from Southwest Parenting. Samantha is also a Vasse PS parent and very much an advocate of supporting parents in their journey of raising children.

Samantha will be presenting a session at Vasse PS on Friday 18 October, 9.45am (after the assembly). You are invited to come along to this session which will be held in the staffroom. The following piece from Samantha explains more;

"Parenting is tough. The demands are constant, the expectations and the pressure we put on ourselves is overwhelming.

Then there are our children. They are so small and vulnerable and dependent on us, yet their struggles and challenging behaviours can make us feel powerless to support them at times".

Samantha Kurowski at Southwest Parenting offers practical, nurturing parenting support. Delivering evidence-based programs helps parents gain the skills and insights to strengthen parent-child relationships, even in difficult circumstances.

Samantha is a parent at Vasse Primary School. She is in the trenches with you all. The parenting session planned is to help support parents so that we can better support the kids to get ready for school and to recover from the demands of school at the end of the day.
